Pursuant to Article 69, Paragraph 1, Subparagraph 2 of the Law on Humanitarian Demining (*Official Gazette*, no. 153/05), the Director of the Croatian Mine Action Centre passed the following document on 16th May 2007:

BOOK OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

ON THE FOLLOWING FORMS: STATEMENT ON MINES AND UXO FOUND ON THE SITE, STATEMENT ON DETERMINED NON-CONTAMINATION OF THE SITE AND/OR BUILDING, STATEMENT ON MINE AND UXO CLEARANCE AND THEIR PARTS, AND REGISTER ON MINE AND UXO DESTRUCTION

Article 1

This Book of Rules and Regulations prescribes statement and record forms submitted to the Croatian Mine Action Centre by authorized legal entities or tradesmen who have conducted demining and/or mine search operations upon the completion of operations.

Article 2

An authorized legal entity or tradesman who have conducted mine search operations and determined non-contamination of the site and/or building shall submit a statement on the determined non-contamination on OIZ-1 Form.

If the submitted statement regards a part of the area covered by the contract it shall be submitted on OIZ-1/_ Form, with the number of statement for a part in question written in the blank space of the form code, and after submitting the statement for the last part of the area covered by the contract, the final statement shall be submitted on OIZ-1 Form with the total area of all previously submitted statements.

The final statement shall be submitted with the site leader's report, stating the total searched area, enclosed.

Article 3

Authorized legal entity or tradesman who while conducting mine search operations determined site and/or building contamination with mines and UXO and their parts shall submit a statement on mines and UXO found on the site on OIZ-2 Form for the part of the project found to be contaminated.

Article 4

Authorized legal entity or tradesman who has conducted demining operations shall submit a statement on mine and UXO clearance and their parts on OIZ-3 Form.

If the submitted statement regards a part of the area covered by the contract it shall be submitted on OIZ-3/_ Form, with the number of statement for a part in question written in the blank space of the form code, and after submitting the statement for the last part of the area covered by the contract, the final statement shall be submitted on OIZ-3 Form with a total area of all previously submitted statements.

The final statement is submitted with the site leader's report stating the total demined area enclosed.

Article 5

Register on mine and UXO destruction shall be submitted by the legal entity or tradesman who has destroyed mines and/or UXO on OUP Form.

Article 6

Forms mentioned in Articles 2, 3, 4 and 5 of this Book of Rules and Regulations are annexed to this Book of Rules and Regulations and are its constituent part.

Article 7

This Regulations Act shall enter into force on the eighth day after the date of publishing in the *Official Gazette*.
